<b>Card 1</b>	What's the title of the story? What are the days of the week? Which countries can you name? Where are you from? Have you got a brother or sister?
<b>Card 2</b>	Are Alex and Sam brother and sister? What are they doing? Where are they? What do they do on Mondays/Fridays? Which objects do you see in their room?
<b>Card 3</b>	Which day is it? What do Alex and Sam do on Sundays? What's the name of their school project? Do you like homework?
<b>Card 4</b>	How do Alex and Sam feel? What's in the box? Who is the box from?
<b>Card 5</b>	Which flags do you see? What is Alex holding? What is Alex doing? Where is the tea cup from?
<b>Card 6</b>	How does Alex feel? Where is Alex? Who do you see? What's on the table? Whose birthday party is it? What does Alex give the queen?
<b>Card 7</b>	Where is Sam? What is she doing? How do the actors feel? Why?
<b>Card 8</b>	Where is Alex? What is Alex eating? Which animal is behind the tent? What does Alex give the park ranger?
<b>Card 9</b>	Where is Sam? Which object brings Sam to Japan? How do you say 'hello' in Japan? Can you wrestle? What's on the table?
